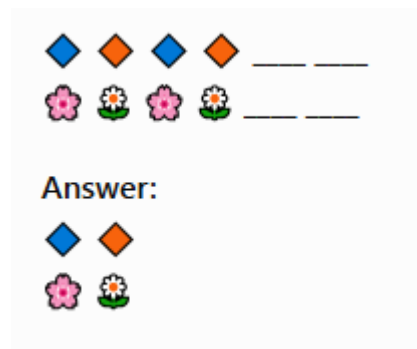

Solution

Step 1: Write the given numbers.

Marbles Rohan has = 36

Marbles his friend gives = 24

Step 2: Choose the operation.

Since Rohan gets more marbles, we add (+).

Step 3: Add the numbers.

$$\begin{array}{r} 36 \\ + 24 \\ \hline 60 \end{array}$$

Step 4: Write the answer.

Answer: Rohan has 60 marbles altogether.
