The Clothes protects us from heat, rain and dust.

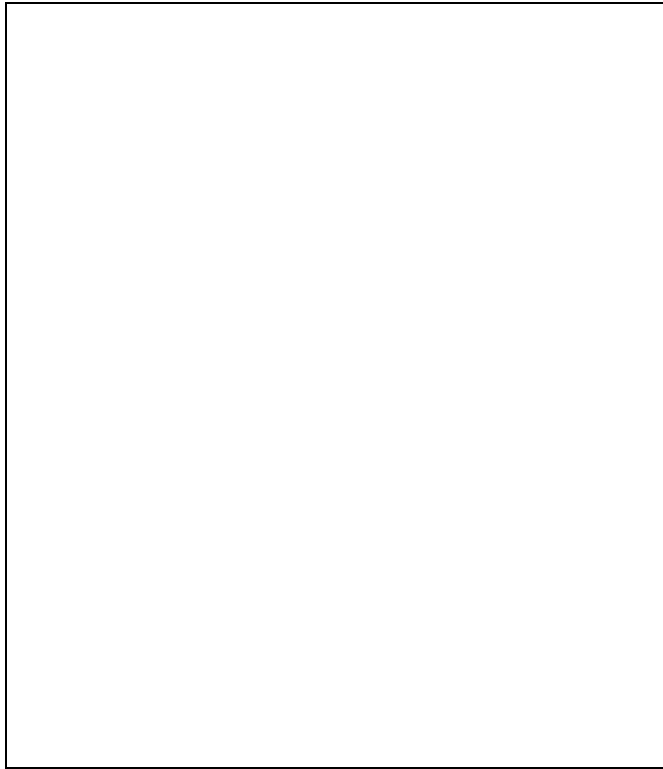

20. What is an organ system? Give examples.

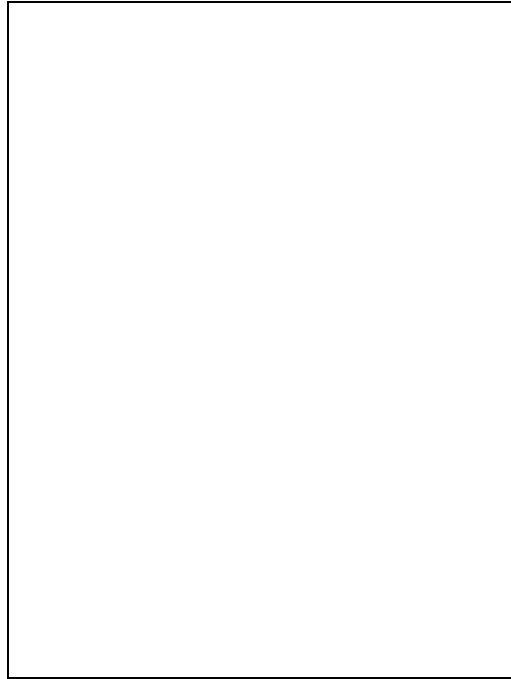
Organ is a body part which carries specific function in the body. Eg. Heart, brain, Kidney etc.
