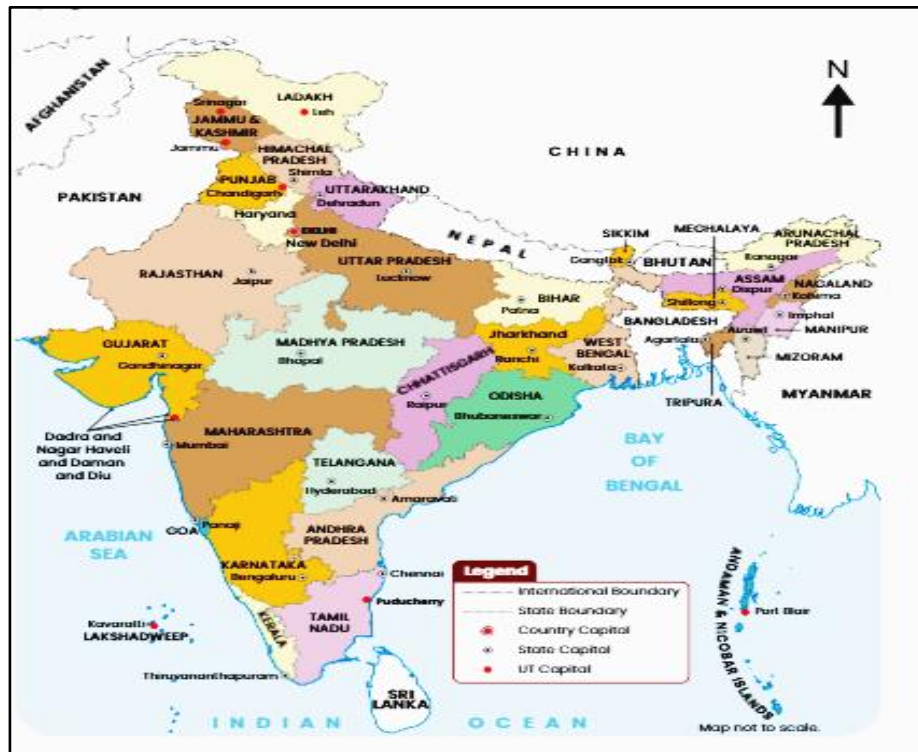

Ans: Provides education through government schools and colleges.

Maintains hospitals and healthcare services.

Builds and maintains roads, bridges, and public transport within the state.

What is the work done by the Chief Minister and the council of Ministers?

Ans: The **Chief Minister** is the head of the State Government and leads the Council of Ministers. The **Council of Ministers** helps the Chief Minister in running the state administration. They make policies, implement laws, and look after the welfare and development of the state. They are responsible for departments such as education, health, agriculture, and transport.

14. Write any three safety rules to protect yourself from strangers. 3
Never go anywhere with a stranger.

Inform a trusted adult if a stranger makes you uncomfortable.

15. Describe any three R's of waste management with one example each. 3
Ans: **Reduce** – Use fewer resources and avoid wasting materials.
Example: Use both sides of a sheet of paper.

Reuse – Use an item again instead of throwing it away.
Example: Reuse glass jars to store spices or stationery.

Recycle – Convert waste materials into new products.
Example: Old newspapers can be recycled to make new paper.
These practices help reduce waste and protect the environment.
